



Please follow the instruction below when taking measurements:

- All measurements should be taken wearing jodhpurs and woollen socks.
- The customer should be standing with his weight evenly distributed on both feet.
- Note that the feet are rested in the mornings but usually swollen in the evenings.
- In the case of boots with long zippers the measurement must be taken from the lower and upper ankle points to the ground

#### 1 FOOT OUTLINE

Please measure both feet and draw the outline of the foot with a thin pen. Keep the pen upright and as close as possible. Please mark where measurements of the joint, instep and heel were taken on the foot outline. Original foot outline should be sent by post, not by fax, as the fax machine may distort the proportions. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### TAKING THE MEASUREMENTS

- 2. Foot length
- 3. Joint of foot
- 4. Instep
- 5. Heel
- 6. Height Measured on the outside of the leg from the floor up to the middle of the knee cap. The leg needs to be slightly bend (see drawing). In taking the height measurement this way, the dropping of the boots is taken into account. (For information about outside curves please read below)
- 7. Calf Please measure around the widest point. For boots which have a long zip down to the floor instead of the reinforcement strip we please need the following measurements: Calf measurements above the floor: A - 25 cm, B - 20 cm, C - 15 cm
- 8. Top This measurement is taken just below the knee cap. Breeches must be pulled smoothly. Should the calf measurement differ more than 3 cm from the top measurement, a short zipper or concealed elastic are recommended. Measurement tape needs to be tight - to be measured over the breech.

# INFORMATION ABOUT THE OUTSIDE CURVES OF THE BOOTS

Models 17000, 17900, 20900, 30900, 40810, 49000 have the high outside curve. To allow for this curve, we will automatically add 1 cm to 1,5 cm to the height measurement that you have given. You will therefore receive boots that are 1 to 1,5 cm higher on the outside than the measurement you have given us.

Models 44900, 75900 have the high outside dressage top. To allow for this curve, we will automatically add to the height measurement that you have given. Boot model 4490X will be 2-2,5 cm higher on the outside and model 7590X will be 2,5-3 cm higher on the outside than the measurements you have given us.
